

CONDITIONS OF OBTAINING APPROVAL TO CONSTRUCT A HANGAR ON THE RANGIORA AIRFIELD

1. RELOCATABLE BUILDINGS

No relocatable buildings will be permitted on the Airfield land.

2. RECYCLED MATERIALS

Hangars must be constructed using new materials and no recycled materials can be used in any hangar.

3. CONSTRUCTION STANDARDS

In general the construction will be as follows:

Concrete floor.

Concrete walls including all internal walls (fire rating to be confirmed).

Steel structural supports.

Galvanized high strength purlins.

Zincalume roof with fibreglass roof light in each hanger.

Steel doors 3.5m high with corrugated colour steel cladding either bi-fold or sectional.

All exterior walls to be painted in a colour acceptable to the Rangiora Airfield committee.

Concrete pad in front of the hangers approximately 3m wide.

Adequate electric lighting.

No toilet facilities.

AUTHORIZED IN WRITING BY
THE MANAGER COMMUNITY AND RECREATION
PRIOR TO THE COMMENCEMENT OF CONSTRUCTION.
