Food Act 2014

Before you start, let's check that you have everything you will need:

- The law requires Councils to verify businesses registered under the Template Food Control Plan (FCP) unless you are a mobile food business trading outside of the Waimakariri District area. In this situation you will need to have a **third party verifier** confirmed as part of your application for registration
- If your business is a registered limited liability company, a copy of the company registration certificate must be attached to this application. See **companies.govt.nz**
- You need to make sure you can confirm that the operator of the food businesses is a resident in New Zealand within the meaning of section YD 1 or YD 2 (excluding section YD 2(2)) of the Income Tax Act 2007
- Payment of your application fee. Refer to the Fees and Charges on the Council website: **waimakariri.govt.nz/services/fees-and-charges**
