

Race Unity Poster Competition Details

- The competition is for pupils in four age groups: 5-7, 8-10, 11-13, 14-16, and a digital category
- Prizes will be provided for the first, second and third place winners in each category
- In addition, the school submitting the most entries proportionate to the school roll will receive a \$300 donation for its art or library fund and the school with the second highest number of entries proportionate to the school roll will receive a \$200 donation
- Students are invited to create an A3 sized poster depicting the theme '*We All Belong*'
- Each pupil may submit more than one entry if they wish
- Joint entries (by two or more pupils) may be submitted but are not eligible for a prize
- Paint, crayons, felt pens, and coloured pencils may be used. Additionally, students can digitally create a poster
- Each entry must include the name and age of the student, and the name of the school on the *front* of the poster using the Entry Label Form provided
- Students may include a short paragraph explaining their poster if they wish
- Posters must be received by 5pm on Wednesday 18 March 2026
- Entries will be judged by members of our local art community
- Entries can be submitted at Rangiora, Kaiapoi or Oxford Library or Rangiora Service Centre, 215 High Street, Rangiora
- Prize winners will be advised by Wednesday 25 March 2026
- A prize-giving ceremony will be held on Tuesday 31 March at 4pm at MainPower Stadium, 289 Coldstream Road, Rangiora.
