We have developed programs such as Seeds of Learning, environment and sustainability practices, animal husbandry, and have embraced the local community in our curriculum. Our focus is to ensure that every student develops the skills and passion to be lifelong learners and contribute to society.

Over the last five years, the school has undergone considerable development to support future growth within our school zone. The Ministry of Education has supported developments such as off-road parking, safe bus pickup, and drop-off zones, a considerable power upgrade, fencing of the entire school, and an upgrade of our teaching spaces.
