## MEMORANDUM OF COUNSEL FOR KĀINGA ORA – HOMES AND COMMUNITIES

- Counsel refer to Minute #20 of the Independent Hearing Panel, and the memorandum provided by Council officers on Strategic Directions dated 27 February 2024.
- In that Minute, the Panel requested that expert conferencing occur on economic and urban growth issues, in advance of the hearings in Stream 12 - Rezonings.
- 3. Kāinga Ora does not have a direct interest in Stream 12, but a number of the questions that have been posed are relevant to matters to be canvassed as part of Stream 7 and Variation 1 Residential and MDRS. To that end, counsel consider it would be beneficial to include expert economic witnesses for parties who intend to participate in Stream 7 and/or Variation 1 within the proposed expert caucusing, even if they are not presenting evidence as part of Stream 12. Otherwise, there is likely to be a degree of duplication between the two streams.
- 4. Counsel seek that the Panel make a further request¹ that expert economic witnesses who intend to file evidence as part of Stream 7 and/or Variation 1 are made available for the purposes of the foreshadowed expert caucusing.
