- 2. Ensure that at all times a copy of the licence, together with a statement of all conditions subject to which it is issued, is displayed—
 - (a) attached to the inside of the premises concerned; and
 - (b) so as to be easily read by people entering each principal entrance
- At all times while a manager is on duty on any licensed premises, the full name of the 3. manager must be prominently displayed inside the premises so as to be easily read by people using the premises; and the person named as manager at any time is to be treated for the purposes of this Act as the manager at that time.


