a) Zack

b) Simoné

- Relay for Life with Cancer Society, raised about approx. \$105,000 (goal \$80,000). It went really well and no major incidents. Held every two years.
- A member of the organisation UN Youth, for high school students, across NZ and Australia. Attended the conference and completed the Aotearoa Youth Declaration for Youth Voices on different issues, such as Oranga Tamariki and Housing. Coming up is the regional meeting, would be great to get involved in.
- Youth MP Representative for Waimakariri 2025 in Youth Parliament. The purpose to get ideas and opportunities from Youth & what you want to see in community.
- Current Project: Youth Opportunities and Accessibility to these. One of the topics is Bus Routes and that they don't reach much of Waimakariri and the time it takes to get into Christchurch. Would like feedback from this group, please let Simoné know.
