The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received. Accordingly we deal with the matter on the papers.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act. We renew the licence on the existing terms and conditions until 2 June 2020 that being three years from the first anniversary of the licence and authorise the issue of a notice of renewal.


The applicant's attention is drawn to ss. 56, 57 and 214(3) of the Act obliging the holder of an On Licence to:-

- Ensure that for each principal entrance to the premises there is displayed at all times a sign attached to the inside or outside of the premises, so as to be easily read by people immediately outside the entrance, stating the ordinary hours of business during which the premises are open for the sale of alcohol.
- Ensure that at all times a copy of the licence, together with a statement of all conditions subject to which it is issued, is displayed—
 - (a) attached to the inside of the premises concerned; and
 - (b) so as to be easily read by people entering each principal entrance
- 3. At all times while a manager is on duty on any licensed premises, the full name of the manager must be prominently displayed inside the premises so as to be easily read by people using the premises; and the person named as manager at any time is to be treated for the purposes of this Act as the manager at that time $NSIN_C$
