- 1. An Authorised Officer under Section 174 Local Government Act 2002 and an Enforcement Officer under Section 177 for the purposes of any offence under the Local Government Act, including offences against bylaws made under this Act. The Enforcement Officer,
 - may seize and impound property that is not on private land in accordance with the conditions stated in Section 164;
 - · has power of entry for enforcement purposes under Section 172,
 - may under Section 178 require certain information if it is believed that an offence under this Act has been committed; and
 - has power of entry to any land or buildings (but not a dwelling-house) for the purpose of checking utility services under Section 182.
- 2. An appointed Dog Control Officer and Dog Ranger pursuant to Section 11 and 12 of the Dog Control Act 1996.
- 3. Authorised to enter private land or premises on behalf of the Waimakariri District Council pursuant to Sections 14. 17. 19 and 19a of the Dog Control Act.
- 4. An appointed person pursuant to Section 8 and 9 of the Impounding Act 1955.
- 5. An Enforcement Officer pursuant to Section 38(1)(a) of the Resource Management Act 1991 for the purposes of Sections 16, 35, 322, 323, 327, 332, AND 343C of this Act.

(Enforcement Officers must hold a security guard's licence issued under Section 26 of the Private Investigators and Security Guards Act 1974.)
