Building Unit

- 1. An Authorised Officer pursuant to Regulation 23 of the Amusement Devices Regulations 1978.
- 2. An Authorised Officer pursuant to Section 222 to carry out inspections of the Building Act 2004.
- 3. An Authorised Officer to issue infringement notices pursuant to Section 372 of the Building Act 2004 and any powers provided in regulations made under this Act.
- 4. An Authorised Officer under the Building Act 2004, Section 164 to issue Notices to Fix.
- 5. An Authorised Officer pursuant to Section 162D of the Building Act 2004.
- 6. An Authorised Officer under Section 174 and an Enforcement Officer under Section 177 of the Local Government Act 2002, for the purposes of any offence under this Act, including offences against bylaws made under this Act. The Enforcement Officer:
 - may seize and impound property that is not on private land in accordance with the conditions stated in section 164;
 - has power of entry for enforcement purposes under Section 172,
 - may under Section 178 require certain information if it is believed that an offence under this Act has been committed; and
 - has power of entry to any land or buildings (but not a dwelling house) for the purpose of checking utility services under Section 182.
