In the end I sold it to buy somewhere else that I could live on land. Therefore, I think if the land title was always small and not subdivided anyone should be able to build not just descendants. Most blocks on the Maori Reserve 873 are smaller size and had been sold by these descendants so it would be unfair that now the landowners cannot build but the descendants can. Every thing should be equal and available to all New Zealanders or my rights are being undermined in favour of Maori. Also it will look odd 7 houses then nothing then along the road another 7 houses and then nothing just empty paddocks it will look disjointed.
