Waimakariri District Council Youth Service Awards 2026

Purpose of the Award

To celebrate the contribution and accomplishments of youth in the Waimakariri District through recognition of the positive impact they have made in the community through their volunteering.

Criteria

- Any person aged 12 to 24 who has made a significant voluntary contribution to the arts, culture, education, health, recreation, sport, welfare, or youth in the Waimakariri District may be nominated.
- The nominee must be between 12 and 24 years as of 1 September 2026.
- Current members of the Youth Council are not eligible for the award.
- Details of the nominee's achievements and successes are required and must be submitted on the official form.
- Please complete all sections of the form with the required information (including the nominee's current contact details).
- A maximum of two (2) youth awards will be awarded in any given year. The Panel's decision is final. The nominators are encouraged to keep the nomination confidential, as not all nominations will be successful.
- Nominations can be made by individual persons, organisations, associations, societies or clubs, such groups can nominate more than one person for consideration.
 - Nominations from individual persons must be from any two (2) citizens of the Waimakariri District.
 - For organisations, associations, societies or clubs, two (2) executive officers etc., must sign the nomination.
- Providing detailed information about the youth's merits and achievements will greatly assist the selection process, including voluntary work, activities and timeframes.
