Based on the information provided, and the complete file submitted to the District Licensing Committee it is determined not to convene a public hearing and to grant the application on the papers.

Accordingly, we deal with the matter on the papers.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.142 of the Act and we grant the applicant a Special Licence.
