1. SUB-P3 (3) SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT

1.1 I have been asked by the Hearings Panel to draft text amendments in relation to my summary statement for Hearing Stream 8, in particular paragraph 1.8 that relates to SUB-P3(3). These amendments are set out below.

SUB – P3 Sustainable Design

Ensure that subdivision design:

- 1. maximises solar gain, including through:
 - a. road and block layout; and
 - b. allotment size, dimension, layout and orientation;
- 2. in Residential Zones, Commercial and Mixed Use Zones, and Open Space and Recreation Zones, supports walking, cycling and public transport; and
- 3. promotes: where appropriate:
 - a. water conservation,
- b. on-site collection of rainwater for non-potable use,
 - b. water sensitive design, and
- c. the treatment and/or attenuation of stormwater prior to discharge, and
- d. where appropriate promotes, the on-site collection of rainwater for non-potable use.
- 4. recognises the need to maintain the design capacity of infrastructure within the public network and avoid causing flooding of downstream properties—and
- <u>5. recognises and provides for the ability to adapt and respond to the effects of climate change and environmental pressures.</u>
