that create excess noise, smoke and fumes, especially those that continue over several days. Events such as this should operate under a notifed resource consent, with strict guidelines. Concerned neighbours must maintain a right to challenge events of this nature.

We ask that council remove provision 1f from RLZ-R16 Rangiora Showgrounds permitted activities. The close proximity of the Rangiora Showgrounds to built-up residential areas makes the venue totally unsuitable for motor vehicle events

- The Rangiora Showgrounds is bordered on two sides by residential areas, a fact which seems to have been ignored by council. The council is fully aware of the issues surrounding the current annual motor vehicle event which causes considerable distress to neighbouring residents. The disruption, noise and inconsiderate conduct of some participants involved with this annual event forces several residents to vacate their homes to seek respite from the event. Therefore, the possibility of multiple motor vehicle events resulting from the proposed 1.f clause, shows a total disregard for the rights of ratepayers/ residents to enjoy their own property without the interference of others.
- The provision appears to remove the rights of residents to voice their
 objections or have any say in the conduct of any motor vehicle event.
 Residents must maintain the right to be able to enjoy their homes without
 being disturbed by events that cause excess noise or shroud their property
 with smoke and fumes.
- The provision is vague, ambiguous and definition is non-existent. Giving no limit on the number of events per year, no limit on who may run these events, no limits to the size or duration of the events, no control over noise levels or pollution from smoke and fumes, and no control over the behaviour of the participants at these events. This therefore appears to be an attempt to legitimise an unlawful existing event to avoid any future legal challenge.
- Further motor vehicle events at the Rangiora Showgrounds would be detrimental to surrounding residential properties by diminishing their value. Once it becomes public knowledge that there are (or could be), multiple motor vehicle events adjacent to residential areas, this will reduce the number of potential buyers, and will reduce the amount buyers are willing to pay to purchase in the vicinity.
