After several ownerships the Fishers bought the mill with the

intention of milling low quality logs to make pallets used amonst other things for food production. This operation had minimal impact on the neighbouring properties and ground impactMr and Mrs Fisher handed the mill activities to their son Arron and since then the operation has grown to become a noise and air pollutant and is actively seeking more

land to expand his buisness ie more than just pallet makeing that we purchased next to.

The entire land slopes towards the town being residential people and houseing, when exess flows occur it naturally gravitates towards houses and people. Given Heavy Industry contaniments this is not a desirable situation looking at future generations. The severe earthquake, 100 year weather event, accidentil spillage etc could be catastrophic for

As the township has and always will grow the original intention of the Fishers could have been accomidated for some time but to grow and now is a timber supplier to other merchants, timber drying facility [previously had others to dry the timber now dry's for others] tanalizing unit, specialty fabrication, public timber and post sales and others is a long way from just pallet production. In short the township does not need this piece of land zoned HIZ and LIZ and a full prodution sawmill withall it's activities or any other activity involving Heavy Industry and the potential consequences a mishap occuring in the future be it weather or man made does not make common sense for this to proceed.
