5. REPORTS FOR DISCUSSION

a) Dan Gordon – Mayor

- o Welcome to visitors, welcome Lauren, and great to see Simone in new role as co-chair.
- Ngā huia at Tuahiwi programme for young people that are not in current education. A wrap around service for learning new skills, then maybe lead to going into a trade or back into school or training. Could welcome a visit from Youth Council.
- o Busy with Annual Plan, consultation opens in mid-March and welcome YC feedback.
- 3-Waters: been collaborating with neighbouring councils to develop options and how they could possibly support each other and will communicate position next week, then there will be consultation with the community.
- O Health Hub at Rangiora: 2 current practices, to relocate to new site at Hospital. Extended or after-hours service. Proposed hours, 7am and 10pm, then St Johns. Council keen to see project proceed for benefit for district. Council and South Link Health have been in talks about council support of the development. Up for Council decision next week. Not uncommon for council to support medical centres (own one in Oxford). In addition, this would be a vital service for our community for access to services & unsure when there would be another opportunity. Already there: Health Hub, Maternity unit, and mobile surgical unit. Has public transport access & good parking.
- Citizenship Ceremonies tomorrow, to swear in new citizens.
- New Idea for a Forum for Head Students at high schools. Dan, starting to work on and talk to principals and work with Lauren.

b) Niki Mealings - WDC Councillor

- First Tuesday of the month is the full council meeting (all day) of the 4 standing committees: Utilities & Roading, Community & Recreation, District Planning and Regulation. Niki is on Utilities & Roading and Community & Recreation.
- Lauren and Lexie presented to council & received approval for the Youth Action Plan.
 Hannah is the YAP representative.
- o Library Update: More than just books, Retro Summer events: Jenga, happy sack etc.
- New shelving going in at Trevor Inch Rangiora Library 16-30 March. Will refresh children's area. Also to make more accessible. There will be a Mobile Library Service with the community van. A new area called the Tinker Zone: digital/technology, 3D printer, robotics, iPad, garage band. To access this there will be an induction required. Soft launch in February after renovation, formal launch before School holidays. Castle going but will be getting a refresh.
- Oxford Pool last day of the season is doggy day on 9th March, where pooch can come have a pool party with other dogs. \$5 entry.
- o Volunteer Expo coming up on 7th, 15th and 21st March. Back to Basic Expo 22nd March.
