This is an application by James A Shand and Mary P Jamieson for a Special Licence in respect of premises situated at 4 Barracks Road Oxford, known as Ribblesdale Gardens to cater for the Oxford Garden Fete scheduled to be held on Sunday 28 October 2018 from 10.00am to 4.00pm.

Reports from the Police, and the Licensing Inspector do not oppose the issuing of the Special Licence. The Medical Officer of Health opposed the application, the grounds of opposition is stated in their report dated 9 October 2018. The opposition from Medical Officer of Health has now been uplifted as confirmed in their report dated 12 October 2018.
