1. An Authorised Officer under Section 174 and an Enforcement Officer under Section 177 of the Local Government Act 2002, for the purposes of any offence under this Act, including offences against bylaws made under this Act. The Enforcement Officer
 - may seize and impound property that is not on private land in accordance with the conditions stated in Section 164;
 - has power of entry for enforcement purposes under Section 172,
 - may under Section 178 require certain information if it is believed that an offence under this Act has been committed; and
 - has power of entry to any land or buildings (but not a dwellinghouse) for the purpose of checking utility services under Section 182.
2. An Enforcement Officer pursuant to Section 38(1)(a) of the Resource Management Act 1991 for the purposes of Sections 35, 322, 327, 332, 333 and 343C of this Act, which provides that the Enforcement Officer:
 - Shall gather such information as is necessary for the Council to carry out its functions under the Act under Section 35;
 - May serve an abatement notice on any person where the Enforcement Officer believes, on reasonable grounds, that the circumstances in Section 322(1) or (2) exist;
 - May direct the occupier of any place emitting excessive noise, or any other person that appears responsible for the noise, to immediately reduce the noise to a reasonable level: Section 327;
 - May, at all reasonable times, go on, into, under or over any place or structure, other than a dwellinghouse, for the purposes, and on the conditions, set out in Section 332, and may take samples of water, air, soil or organic matter, including contaminants;
 - May, for purposes connected with the preparation, change or review of the District Plan, carry out any of the functions described in Section 333 including: surveys, investigations, tests or measurements, taking samples; entering or re-entering land (but not a dwellinghouse); and
 - May serve an infringement notice on any person observed committing an infringement offence (as specified in the Regulations), in the manner set out in Section 343C.
3. An authorised Officer pursuant to Sections 55 and 57 of the Transit New Zealand Act 1989.
4. An Authorised Officer pursuant to section 222 of the Building Act 2004.
