Fire and Emergency New Zealand – Letter to be tabled for Proposed Waimakariri District Plan: Matepā māhorahora – Natural Hazards Chapter

Fire and Emergency New Zealand (Fire and Emergency) made a submission on the Proposed Waimakariri District Plan: Matepā māhorahora – Natural Hazards Chapter. Fire and Emergency has opted not to attend the hearing scheduled to commence on 3 August 2023 and requests that, in lieu of attendance, this letter be tabled for the Hearing Commissioners' consideration.

Fire and Emergency's Submission

Fire and Emergency made a number of recommended changes to the Proposed Waimakariri District Plan.
