The property has been extensively renovated and altered over the last 40 years and there is nothing original remaining of the original structure. Internally it has been gutted and the layout changed. The cladding has all changed and the chimneys have all been removed. All original materials were removed or destroyed during these renovations.

The land on which the house sits has been extensively dug over and landscaped and nothing of archeological value remains.

There are several other houses in the village of similar age which are not proposed to be classified as heritage buildings - only our house and the two churches in the village. This is unfair.

This classification would impact our potential future use of the property and it's resale value all because someone who has no stake holding in it has decided it should be a heritage building. We specifically checked that it did not have heritage status before buying it and object to the financial ramifications that this decision may have on our family future. The history of the property is sufficiently documented for anyone interested, without the need to impact our family's financial situation.
