Greenspace Manager Aquatic Facilities Manager Libraries Manager	Trespass Act 1980  For the purposes of giving a warning to leave under Section 3 and giving a warning to stay off a place under Section 4.	
Greenspace Manager	Other  To approve intrusions or not allow intrusions through recession planes of buildings adjoining parks.  To grant or decline permits (other than leases or licences) for activities on reserves.  To require bonds for any use on Council parks property.  Authority to grant consent for the removal of dead, diseased or dying trees from parks, reserves, streets or other Council land (excluding trees listed as notable in the District Plan)
