Section 33 sets out the Government's policies for reimbursing local authorities for some of the costs incurred responding to and recovering from emergency events.</i>  <i>NEMA is reviewing Section 33 because the Guide was last substantively reviewed in 2015, at the same time as the current version of the National Plan. Since 2015, feedback from stakeholders and reviews of past responses to emergency events have highlighted that some aspects of the financial support framework may not be working optimally, particularly for large-scale events like Cyclone Gabrielle.</i>	None	<i>Draft the Council's Submission</i>
