#### Where:

- a maximum of five staff shall work on the site at any one time:
- the manufacture, processing or production of goods involves initial or further processing of commodities derived from primary production;
- 3. the maximum GFA occupied for the rural industry shall be 250m<sup>2</sup>:
- the maximum GFA occupied for the rural industry within a SASM shall be 150m<sup>2</sup>:
- 5. the maximum land area occupied for the rural industry shall be 500m<sup>2</sup>;
- 6. any retail sales area shall be set back a minimum of 10m from the site boundary:
- 7. the retail sale of goods on the site is restricted to those manufactured, produced or processed on the site;
- 8. the maximum NFA or land area occupied for retail sales shall be 50m<sup>2</sup>; and
- 9. any buildings, yard, storage, or parking areas associated with the activity shall not be located within 60m of any residential unit, or other sensitive activity, located on a site other than where the rural industry is occurring.

Sentiment: Oppose

#### Submission:

Scottville Farm is concerned about the following proposed rules:

The maximum of 5 staff under **GRUZ-R11(sub clause 1)** is insufficient for any rural industry activity. It has been long know that the handling/packing/processing etc. of primary production, particularly horticulture is very labor intensive. 5 staff would be the minimum you would need not the maximum. It would be accentuated in smaller operations where the investment of automation is not economically viable.

The relief/outcome we seek is the maximum be increased from 5 to 15 staff.

The GFA under **GRUZ-R11** (sub clause 3) should be increased to 550m2 to align itself with the GFA in the section **GRUZ-BFS6** My concern is the processing of primary production goods require larger equipment, and handling equipment i.e. forklifts. It is a **high risk health and safety issue** when compacting a lot equipment into smaller buildings/sheds and then incorporating 1,2 or even 3 forklifts.

The relief/outcome we seek is the GFA be increased from 250m2 to 550m2.

Subsequently **GRUZ-R11** (sub clause 5) should be increased to 5000m2. Fresh produce is a very bulky product. A small production are i.e. 10 or 15ha requires a lot of bins and storage area. If the product is exported there can be area needed for up to 8+ shipping containers. To give an example: 1ha of onions can produce 80tons of product which is 3x 40ft shipping containers or 80x 2 cubic meter produce bins.

The relief/outcome we seek is the maximum land area occupied for the rural industry is increased to 5000m2

Scottville Farm has great overall support for the purpose, objectives and policies in the proposed plan, but we do sincerely feel that **GRUZ-R11** rules should be more generous and practical.
