Land use for medium density residential will not be compatible with the Boards educational purposes and it is noted that other possible land use designations are provided for in the proposal that will be consistent the Board's objectives.

The Board is generally supportive of the proposed change of land use in the NER North East Rangiora Development area. The changes are seen as positive for the wider community that the school serves.

These are risks that can be managed through carefully planned development activites and by ensuring that the amount of land able to be used for educational purposes is not reduced under whichever of the options is found to be preferred.
